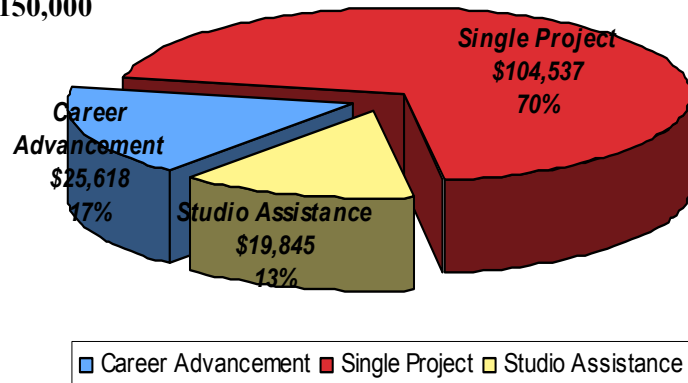


MakeWork Allocations by Grant Category
